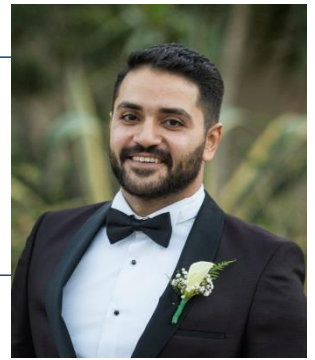


MOSTAFA MOHAMED YEHIA Hussein, PMP®

- Exercised appropriate cost control to maintain monthly CPI & SPI within accepted range by using Earned Value (EV) and To-Complete Performance Index (TCPI) Analysis.

- Developed a structural design for new extensions of assigned projects that was completed within budget and on time.
- Created detailed Drawings and specifications for complex reinforced concrete structures, including foundations, columns, beams, slabs, walls and other elements.
- Saved the company time and money by accurately calculating the required reinforcement needed for the Holy Mataf Flat Slab using macro-ready Excel sheets. This enabled a decrease in the reinforcement from 36mm-dia to 24mm-dia, which could be purchased locally, while taking into consideration all safety factors.
- Collaborated with architects and other engineers to develop innovative solutions that meet aesthetic requirements while still providing structural integrity and safety.
