JOB DESCRIPTION

ROLE AND DUTIES OF THE CIRCULATING NURSE

Circulating Nurse has the major role in managing the operating room.

Circulating Nurse has an overall picture of the needs.

Duties are as follows:

- Check clear linens in the disposal units.
- Make sure that diathermy and suction are plugged in ready to move into position once patient is on the table.
- Provides pathology forms and a selection of specimen containers.
- Has table and the other accessories available for use.
- Checks the scrub room for brushes, antiseptic solution, gown and glove supply.
- Assist the surgeon in gowning.
- Assist the scrub nurse in gowning.
- Counts with scrub nurse instruments, sponges and sharps and enters the counts on the scrub check board.
- Responsible for all documentations.
- Helps to position the patient on the operating table.
- Microscope when used is moved with great care.
- Circulating nurse does not leave the theatre unless there is another nurse to assist the scrub nurse.
- Maintains a quiet environment and necessary conversation is avoided.
- Circulating nurse helps with the transfer of the patient off the operating table and into the recovery trolley.
- Circulating nurse escorts the patient to the recovery room if anesthetic and recovery staffs are busy.
- Circulating nurse checks the operating room and makes sure the every equipment and machine used are replaced and in order.
- See to it that the floor is mopped dry and table wiped down ready for the next surgery.

ROLE AND DUTIES OF THE SCRUB NURSE

A. ROLE

- The primary role of the scrub nurse is to anticipate the needs of the surgeon and assist at the operative site.
- Has thorough knowledge of the aseptic technique.
- Has the ability and stamina to work efficiently under pressure.
- Has a good manual dexterity and organization skills.

B. DUTIES

- Prepare his/her trolley for their own case.
- Scrub Nurse knows exactly what is in the trolley at the start of the case is on his/her.
- Scrub Nurse consults the cardex for the surgeon's special regular requirements before the trolley is set.
- Scrub Nurse sees that everything is handy inside the OR to prevent unnecessary excursion in and out of the theatre.
- Closed glove technique is preferred for all surgeries.
- Scrub Nurse checks the control tube and the instrument set at the beginning of trolley setting.
- Scrub Nurse Counts, with circulating nurse instruments, needles, and sponges, and circulating records the count on swab check board.
- Scrub Nurse assist the surgeon with the application of the skin antiseptic
- Scrub Nurse assist the surgeon.
- Announces to the surgeon the diathermy setting before handling him the diathermy forceps.
- Scrub Nurse familiarizes herself with each surgeon's needs and requirements so he/she can be one step.
- Scrub Nurse Counts with the circulating nurse towards the end of the surgery, or in abdominal operation, before the closure of the peritoneum.
- Scrub Nurse counts with the circulating nurse again for one second time, and the result clearly announced to the surgeon who must indicate that he has hear that you stated the count.
- Scrub Nurse sees to it that the patient looks neat and clean before transferring from the operating room to the recovery room.
- Specimen taken during surgery are the responsibility of the scrub nurse.
- The register of operation should be filled in after each case.
- Scrub Nurses must clear up after their own cases unless they scrub again immediately for a following case.

ROLE AND DUTIES OF THE OPERATING ROOM IN-CHARGE / TEAM LEADER
